### DRILLING PROGRAMME COMMENCES AT BROUGHTON CREEK

Orion Metals Limited (ASX:ORM) is pleased to announce that it has commenced a reverse circulation drilling programme at Broughton Creek (EPM 16209) in northwest Queensland for uranium and rare earth element mineralisation. EPM 16209 is located approximately 30km to the south of the historical Mary Kathleen uranium mine. The programme will consist of a series of exploratory drillholes designed to test a number of coincident radiometric and rock chip geochemically anomalous zones. The planned drilling programme consists of 16 angled drillholes for a total of 1500m. The programme is expected to be completed within two weeks.

The Broughton Creek Project is a joint venture with Broughton Minerals Limited where Orion Metals is farming into the project and is project manager.
